EQUIPMENT LIST

ALL EXAMINATIONS

- You are expected to provide basic equipment such as biros, lead pencils, rulers and erasers for ALL EXAMINATIONS.
- Any equipment brought into the examination room will be subject to INSPECTION before the examination commences.
- Equipment should only bear the ORIGINAL inscribed information.
- It is the responsibility of the candidate to supply equipment which is in good working order (this includes calculators). Equipment failure is not a ground for a claim to be made under misadventure provisions.
- All calculators which are permitted in particular subjects must meet the following criteria:
 - hand-held
 - silent (except in approved cases for blind candidates)
 - In addition, calculators which allow modules to be plugged in are permitted only if they meet all the above requirements, and all plug-in modules are removed.

Where the equipment list for any subject includes a scientific calculator, you are expected to provide a calculator which has been approved by the Board of Secondary Education.

An approved scientific calculator may be used for any examination where a calculator is listed as required or optional.

BIOLOGY

You must provide the following:

- ☐ a B pencil
- ☐ a soft eraser
- ☐ a metric ruler

Calculators and geometrical instruments are optional.
