# **EQUIPMENT LIST**

## **ALL EXAMINATIONS**

- You are expected to provide basic equipment such as biros, lead pencils, rulers and erasers for ALL EXAMINATIONS. Any equipment brought into the examination room will be subject to INSPECTION before the examination commences.
- Equipment should only bear the ORIGINAL inscribed information.
- It is the responsibility of the candidate to supply equipment which is in good working order (this includes calculators). Equipment failure is not a ground for a claim to be made under misadventure provisions.
- All calculators which are permitted in particular subjects must meet the following criteria:
  - hand-held
  - silent (except in approved cases for blind candidates)
  - In addition, calculators which allow modules to be plugged in are permitted only if they meet all the above requirements, and all plug-in modules are removed.

Where the equipment list for any subject includes a scientific calculator, you are expected to provide a calculator which has been approved by the Board of Studies. An approved scientific calculator may be used for any examination where a calculator is listed as required or optional.

## **EQUIPMENT CHECKLIST FOR** SPECIFIC SUBJECTS

## **AGRICULTURE**

You must provide the following:

- a metric ruler
- a B pencil
- an approved scientific calculator

### **CHEMISTRY**

You must provide the following

- a B pencil
- a soft eraser
- an approved scientific calculator
- a straight edge ruler

Use of slide rules and geometrical instruments is optional.

## **PHYSICS**

You must provide the following:

- a B pencil
- a soft eraser
- an approved scientific calculator
- a straight edge metric ruler
- a pair of compasses
- a protractor
- a set square or parallel ruler

The use of a slide rule is optional.

## EGONOMICS AND REPEAT CANDIDATES

You must provide the following:

- a B pencil
- a soft eraser

The use of an approved scientific calculator is optional.
