### ALL EXAMINATIONS

battery or solar powered

hand-held

You must provide the following

a B pencil

silent (except in approved cases for blind students)

in addition, calculators which allow modules to be plugged in are permitted only if they meet all the above requirements, and all plug-in

Where the equipment list for any subject includes a scientific calculator, you are expected to provide a calculator which has been approved by the Board of Studies. An approved scientific calculator may be used for any examination where a calculator is listed as required or optional.
